

**ICHM Masters Degree for HFThun graduates: 1 year study in Australia and 6 month paid work in Switzerland including handing in research documents**  
**Cost overview**

**Must have** before entering in Master Degree Study Programme at ICHM, Adelaide, Australia

- HFThun diploma, which is at EQF level 6. Therefore graduates from HFThun can enter the ICHM Master Degree directly in semester 2.
- English at IELTS 6.5 or C1 e.g. BEC Higher Certificate (C1), Cambridge Advanced (C1)

**Alternative Structure:** It is possible to work in Australia for two years after ICHM Master graduation. In this case the model is: three semesters with three subjects per semester, followed by work placement. The cost is higher by one subject (\$3750 less bursary), and living cost for one semester. You must decide which model you would prefer before commencement.
